  - 30 days in advance of your wedding day, **IF all of your music has been chosen from the list.** Please return the completed form by email or in person, to the Knox Office.

• 60 days in advance of your wedding day, **IF** you have chosen additional music that is **NOT** on the list. These requests must be reviewed and approved by the Music Director. Please submit your requests, by email or in person, to the Knox Office.
